

ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION NOTICEApplication for a Permit Amendment Under the Provisions of the *Environmental Management Act*

We, Sinclair Group Forest Products Ltd. dba. Premium Pellet Ltd., intend to submit this amendment application to the Director to amend Permit 16502, issued December 27, 2000 and last amended November 20, 2012 which authorizes the discharge of air emissions from a Wood Pellet Plant.

The land upon which the facility is situated and the discharge occurs is Lot A, Plan B, TMP. 45107, Folio 512355, Coast District, British Columbia, located at 2301 Campbell Rd, Vanderhoof, British Columbia, within the District of Vanderhoof.

The amendment requests that the following conditions be changed from existing permitted equipment, including a wood fibre dryer with dual, high efficiency cyclones and related emissions control cyclones and baghouses with a total particulate matter loading rate of 22.9 kg/hr to include new equipment, including: one wood fibre dryer with a multi-cyclone, one chiller with a cyclone, one hammer mill with cyclone and baghouse, and one cyclone for the biosizer and dryer line. The new sources are summarized in Table 1 with a total, additional particulate matter loading rate of 20.1kg/hr. The operating period for this facility will remain unchanged.
